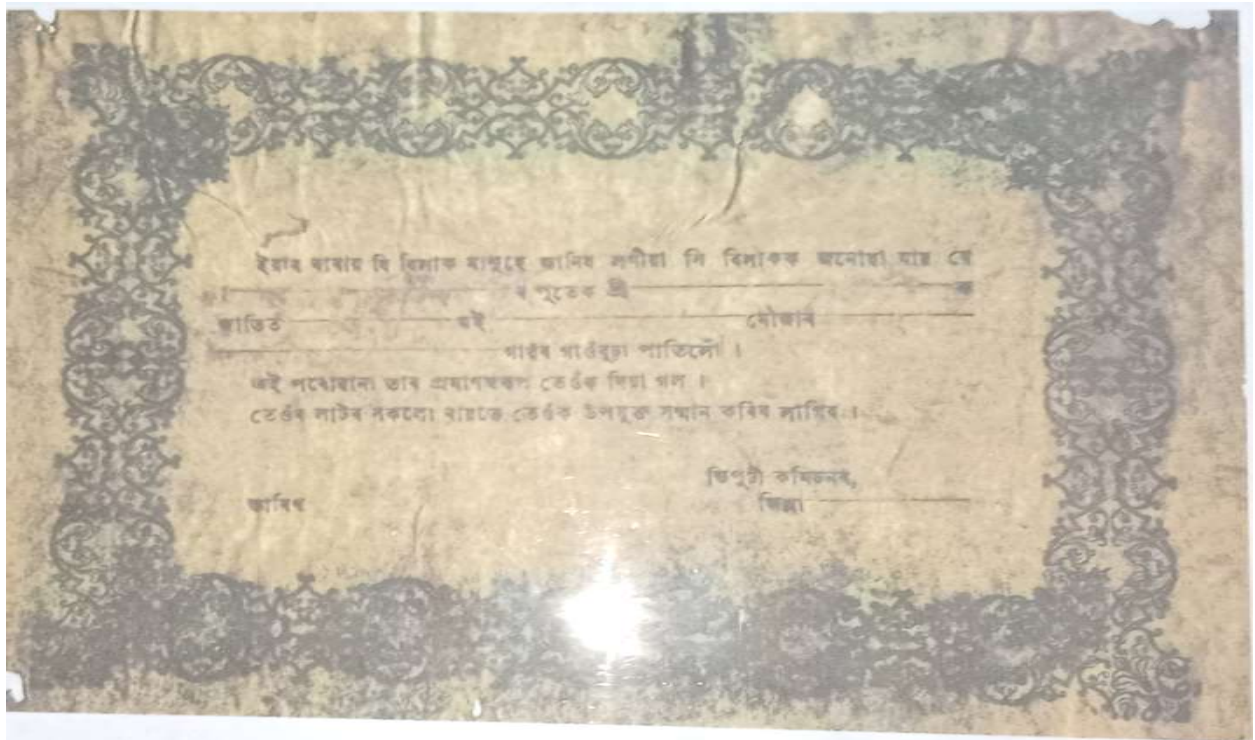
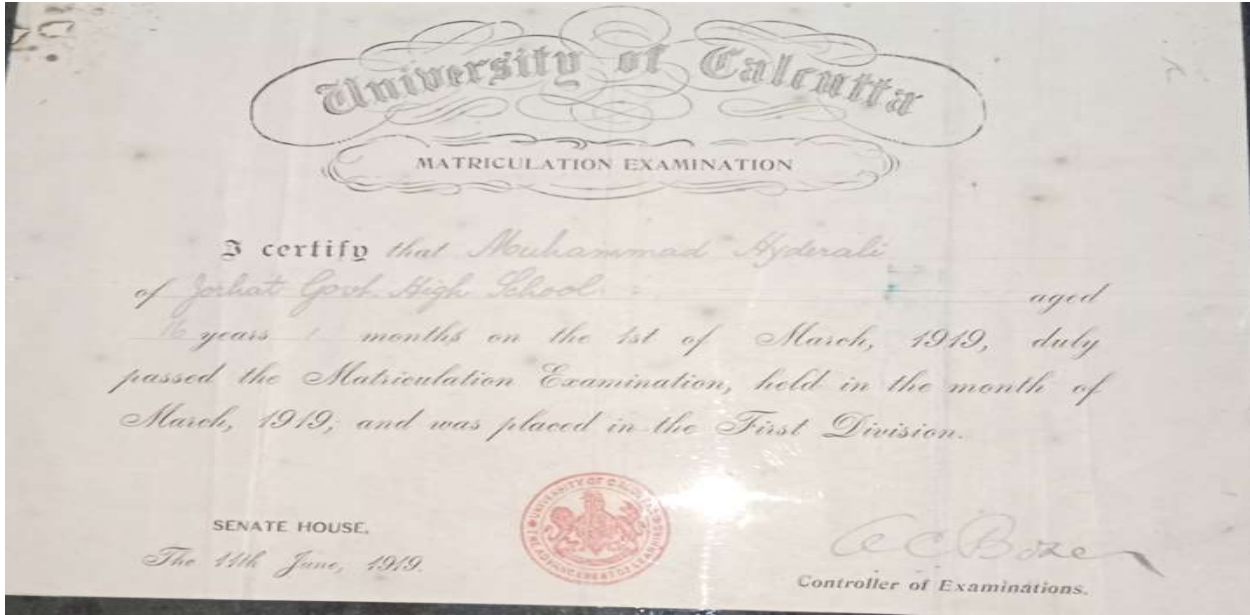




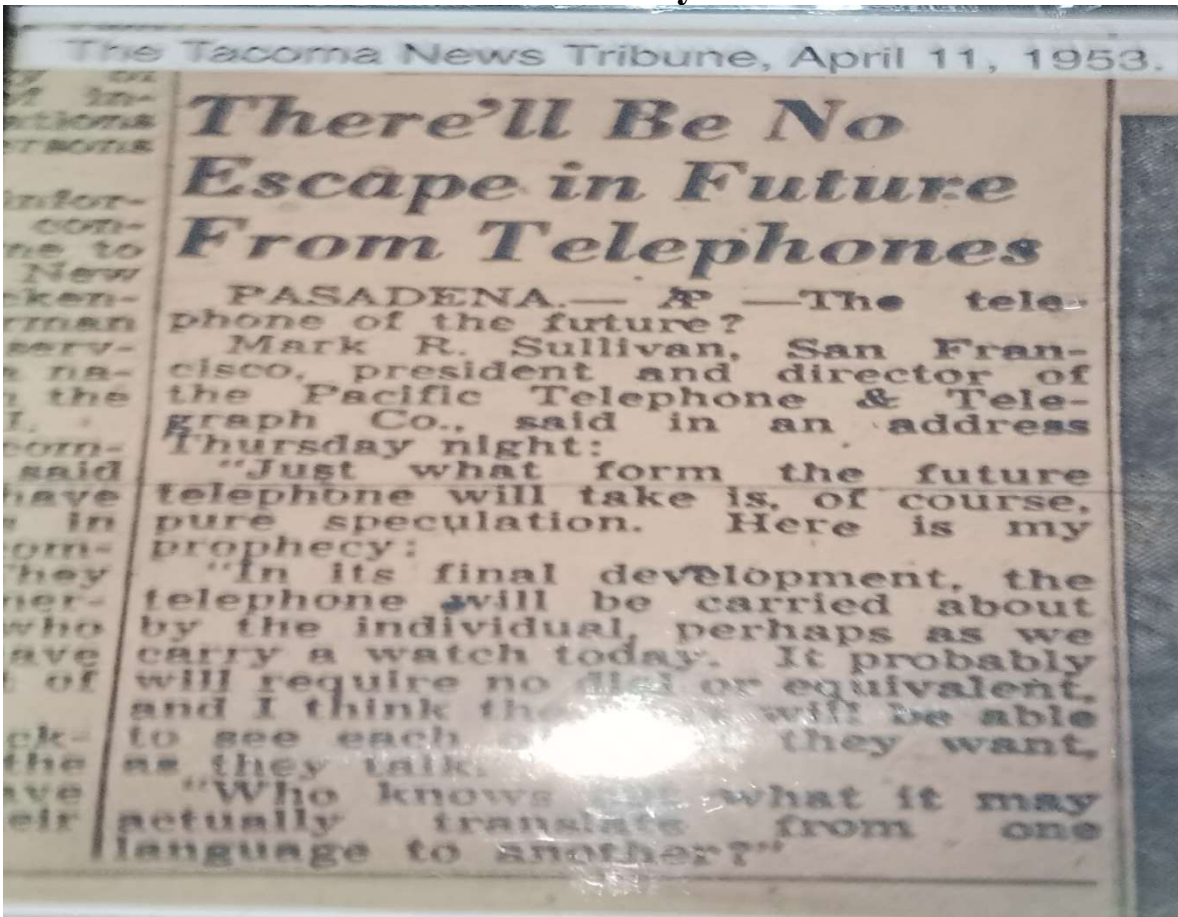
Jorhat Railway Station in the year of 1954



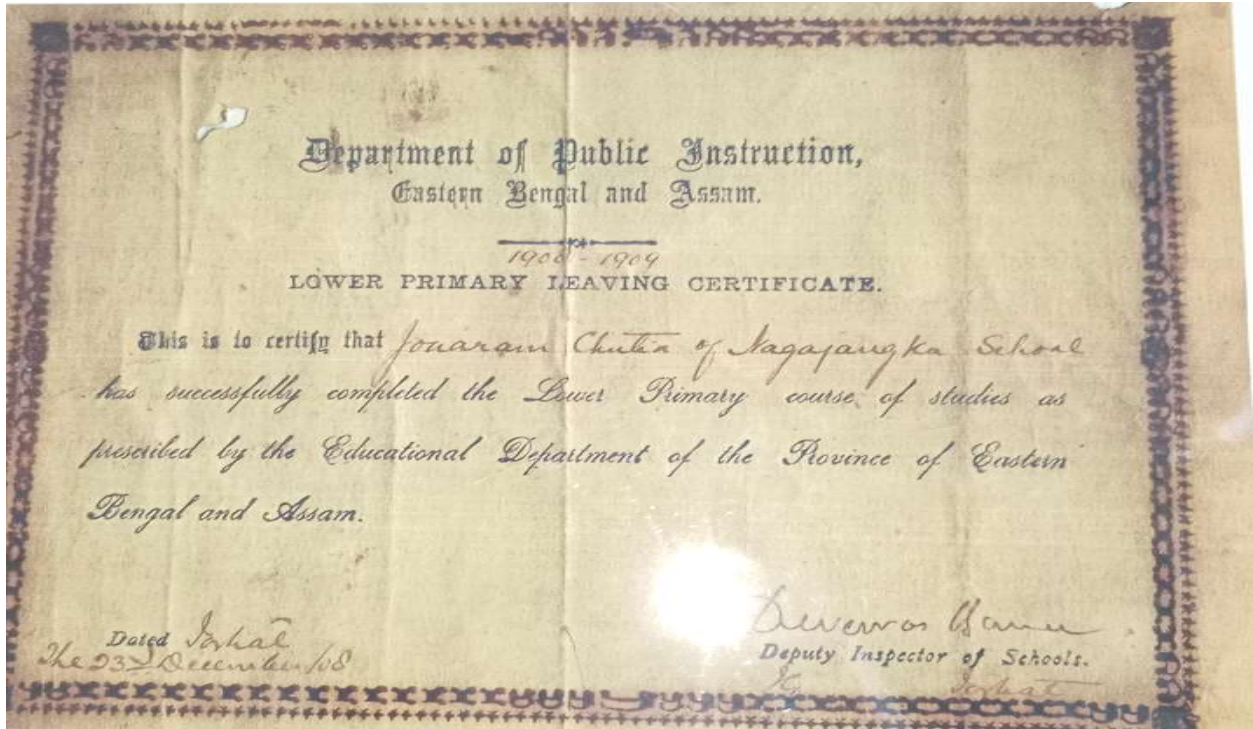
An appointment letter of Village Pradhan(Goan Burha) the Deputy Commissioner during the British Period in 1909

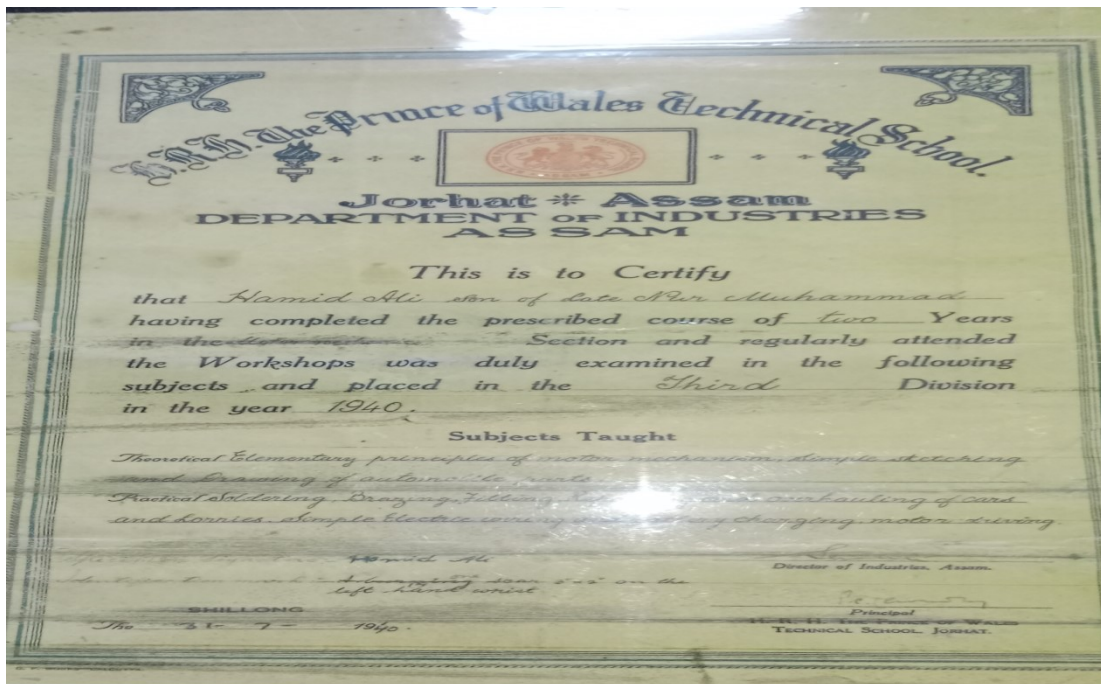

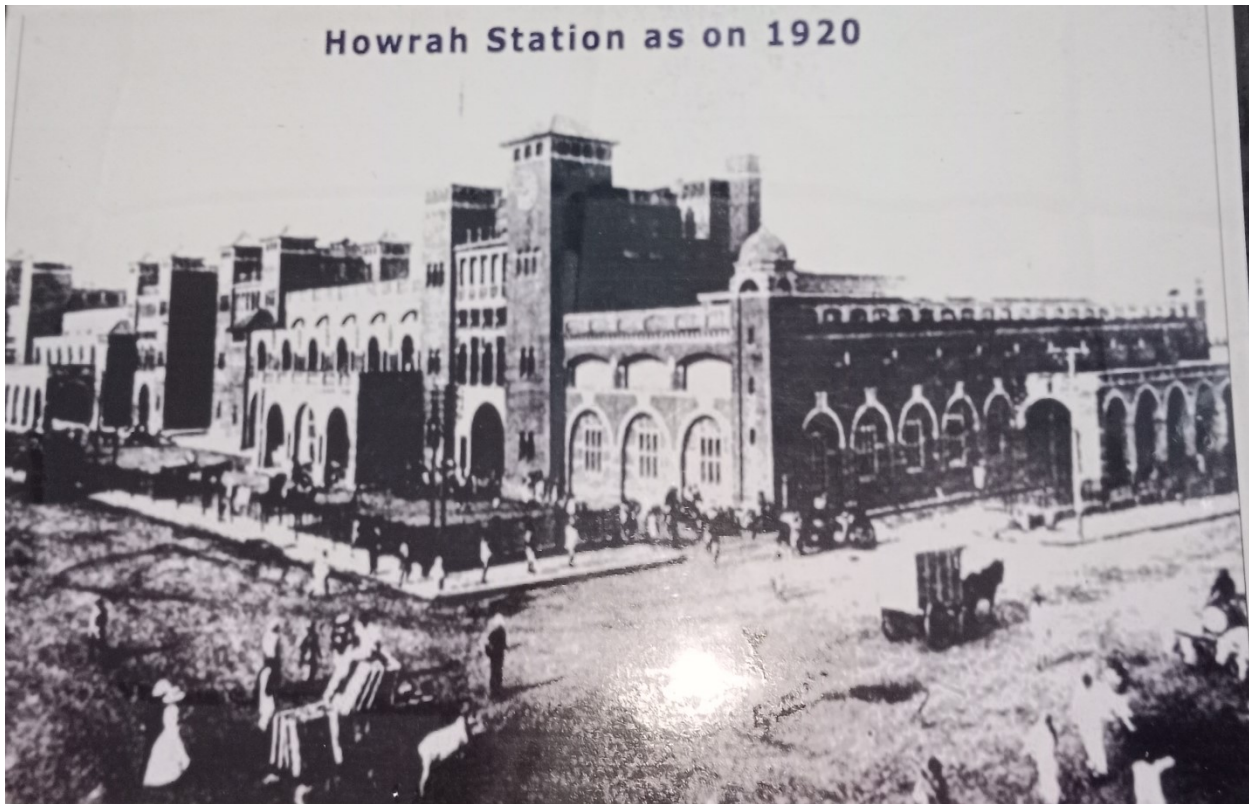


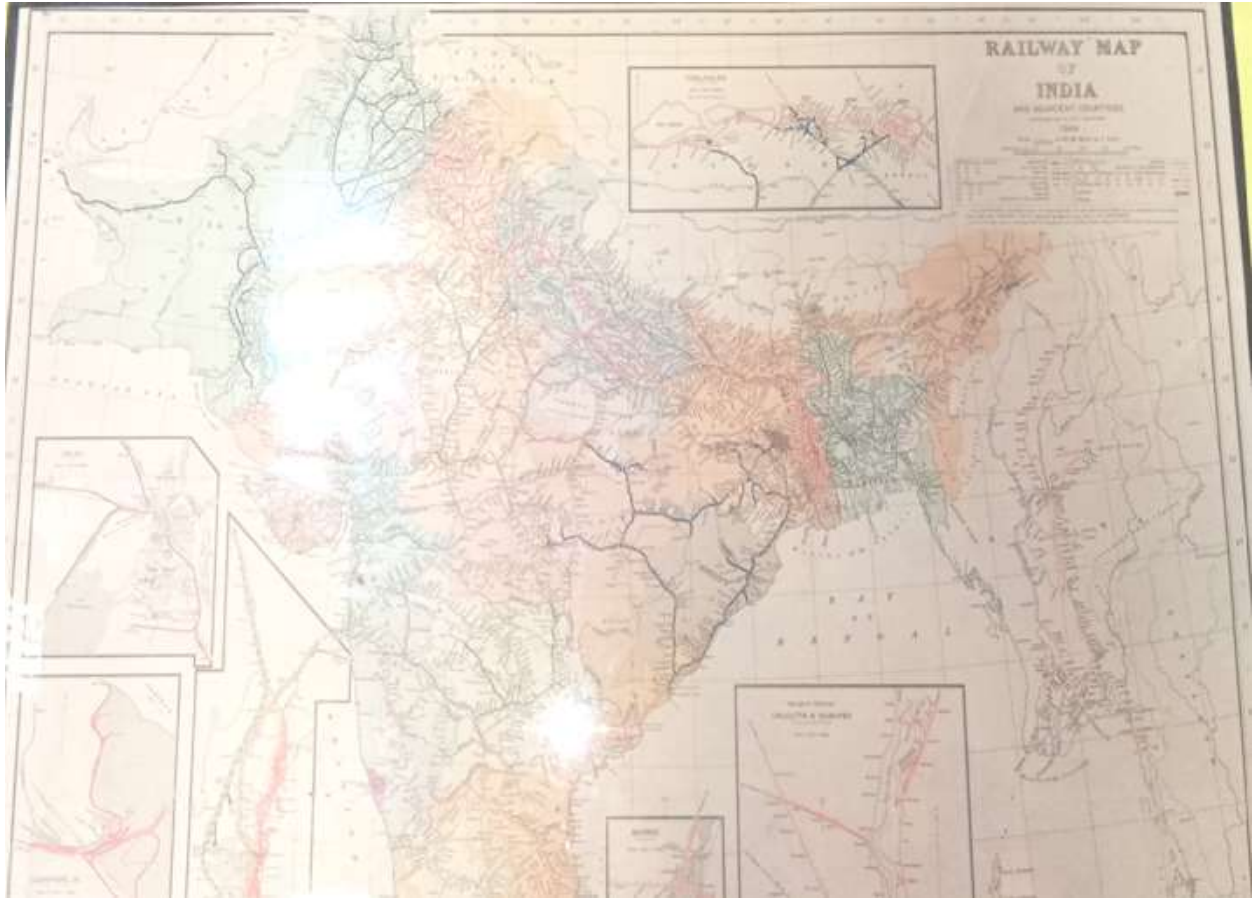

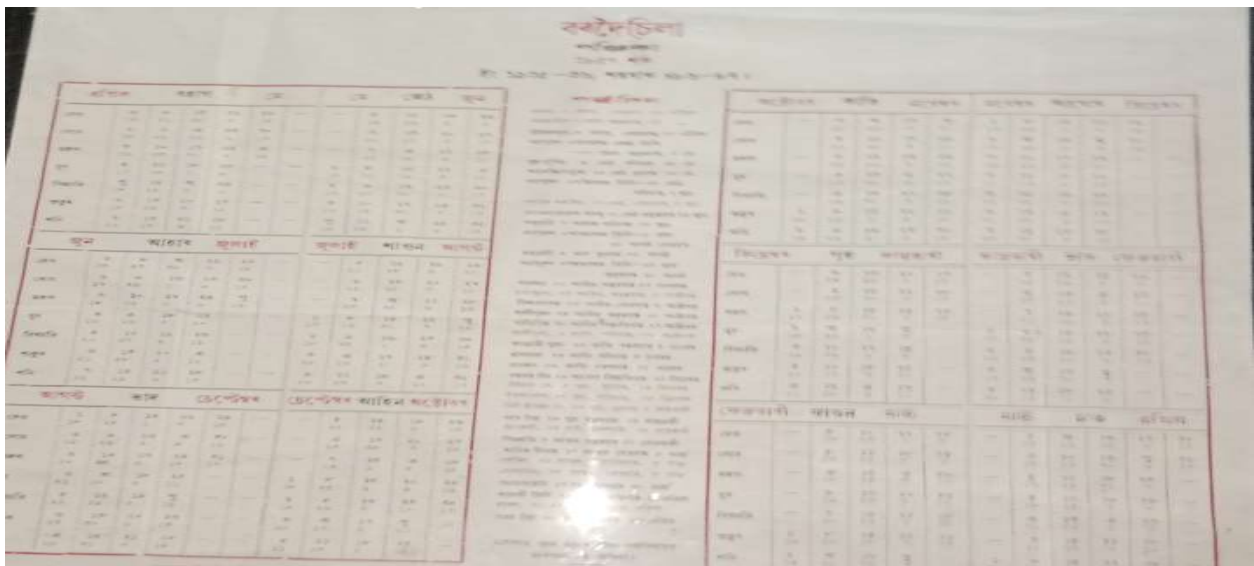

Assamese Calendar of 1937



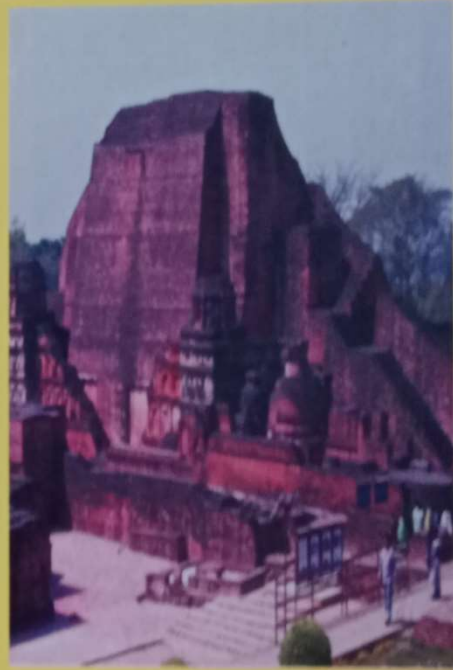
