**CINNAMARA COLLEGE** was established on 1<sup>st</sup> June in 1991 at the centre of three *mouzas* Katoni, Garamur and Charaibahi of the Southern part of the Jorhat District, Assam, near Cinnamara High School, was shifted to its permanent site on Ist June in 1998. The name of the College Campus is known as *KABYAKSHETRA*. The College Campus is located at the vicinity of ONGC, Cinnamara Complex, F.C.I. godown and opposite to Cinnamara Rly Station. The College campus is connected by its own approach road from southward (Jibeswari Katoni Path, distance only 230 meters) with Jorhat-Mariani road. The other College approach road is ‘Aragami Path’ from eastward (distance only 350 meters) leads from ONGC, Bagdhara road (opposite to ONGC gate) to College campus. Cinnamara is a prominent name in the growth of tea industries of Assam. Mani Ram Dewan, the martyr of the first war of independence in 1857, established his first tea garden here at Cenimora in 1846. The adjacent area of Cinnamara is known as Karanga, the hub of indigenous blacksmith craft of Assam. It is a fact that the elite section of this vast region cherished a dream to establish a college either at Karanga or at Cinnamara since the time of independence. Several efforts were made in this direction but of no avail. However, the dream of the south Jorhatians got translated into reality in 1991 when Cinnamara College was established under the dynamic patronage of Sjt. Durlav Chandra Mahanta, Sjt Mohan Ch. Katoni, Sjt. Hitendra Nath Goswami and a dedicated coterie of social workers of the neighbouring areas. In this historic mission Sjt Ananda Saikia was undeniably the steward, the founder principal and the doyen of our College. Within a fairly shorter span of time our College has been able to showcase a conspicuous academic, intellectual, cultural and social stimulation. Our college has laid emphasised on social research through its research centre Mohan Chandra Mahanta Research Centre being established on 2nd October, 2010. In addition, a unit of Sakha Sahitya Sabha registered under Asam Sahitya Sabha was also established and hopefully under the Sakha’s banner we have so far published more than 179 Books and Journals having ISBN and ISSN tag. The college is also successfully conducting KKHSOU and Dibrugarh University Distance Education Study Programmes offering various converntional and professional courses. Besides, realizing the historical significance of the southern part of greater Jorhat district, the college has started a Museum and archieve in the recent past. In 2016, the college has completed its glorious Silver Jubilee celebration.





## Infra-Structure

Altogether 33 spacious permanent pacca rooms have been constructed for Common room, Class room, Boys' Common room, Girls' Common room along with spacious stage ahead of the main building. Every room is well equipped with electric fan, light etc. Besides, the permanent building complex was designed by a distinguished architect of Jorhat Development Authority in collaboration with G. B. member (Technical expert) late Hassan Ali Hazarika. The total cost of the whole project is estimated to be more than one crore. A portion of class rooms of the original project have already been constructed with financial back up extended by the Hon'ble M.P. Jorhat HPC and Jorhat Development Authority. Further, a spacious Library building has been donated by Mr. O.P. A reading room attached to the same being donated by Dr. Anjan Saikia, Principal of the College. In addition, Mr. Bajranglal Bhusa and Mr. Makhanlal Gattani, local entrepreneurs, have donated two class rooms. Mr. Harendra Nath Rajbonshi of Mangaldoi donated the entrance gate in memory of his brother late Giridhar Deka who was an ex-student of this College. Mr. Dulu Gogoi, a resident of Karanga, donated the iron gate of the entrance. Dr. Harendra Nath Gogoi, President, Governing Body, donated 2.5 Lakh in order to complete the college stage. Similarly, Prof. Ananda Saikia, founder Principal of the College has donated a room in memory of his father '*Nitaram Gaonburha*'. Another room was constructed in memory of Hemkanta Bordoloi, founder Head Master of Cinnamara High School and one of the Chief Patrons of our College under the initiative of teaching and non-teaching staff, founder Principal, well-wishers and family members of late Bordoloi. Besides, local O.N.G.C. released four lakh in order to complete a class room. In the same way, Mr. Kamal Chandra Hazarika, one of the founding personalities of our College has donated an arch in memory of his father to College. The College has also obtained MPLAB fund in order to construct building, is completed. Similarly, College received grants from UGC in order to construct the women hostel, is completed and inaugurated on 22<sup>nd</sup> July, 2017. The women hostel of the college is running with 14 boarders very smoothly. A conference hall is also completed with the financial assistance of Principal, Dr. Anjan Saikia and the teaching staff of the College. In addition, local O.N.G.C. again released 9.92 lakh for the construction of multi-purposed examination hall. Above all, the government of Assam has also declared one crore for the infra-structural development of the college and out of it, 50 lakh is being released as a first installment, is completed. The second installment is under process.

The overall scenery of the College is now very attractive with a flower garden in front of the College building, and fishery within College campus. The saplings of areca nut, coconut, evergreen coniferous tree like *Debdaru* have been planted abundantly on the surroundings of College compound



for keeping an evergreen natural atmosphere permanently. Hence the immediate surroundings of the College campus are calm and quiet. It is free from any nuisance and the healthy atmosphere prevails which helps the students to absorb their mind in deep study. Here the pupil can learn under a natural atmosphere. In fact, our academic programme is designed to embrace the diversity, to encourage individuality and to support students attempting high risk education. So our green, a little *Santiniketon* like campus is international cross roads, where renowned Educationists, Scientists, Social Scientists and Social Workers come to speak and share new ideas with us. And our College located in the historic region of Jorhat District offers unlimited variety for intellectual, cultural and culinary stimulation. It is worth mentioning here that dynamism, unending urge for innovation and an infinite curiosity to explore the new horizons of knowledge are the cardinal motivating forces for our College.

Although our college has made substantial progress during the past twenty eight years, much more still awaits to be realized. Our accomplishments will not deter us from our quest for progress as there has been always a better future than the past. Given the mandate of the spread of knowledge by our torch-bearers the 'saga of progress' will continue its journey to materialise the vision and mission the founders of the college set for us.

## Award of Sresthashra

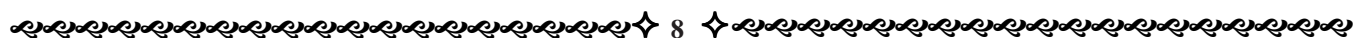

## College Uniform

White Shirt and Black Trouser (**For Boys**) and white Mekhela Chadar with Navy Blue border and Navy Blue Blouse **or** White Churider-Pyzama with Navy-Blue Chuni (**For Girls**). **The Navy-Blue/Black sweater is compulsory in the winter season. In addition to, the uniform prescribed by the college authority is compulsory.**

## Student Union

The Student Union is the premier student body in the college. Its membership is compulsory for all students of the college. it cultivates the qualities of leadership, public speaking, organization, self expression and initiative among the students. ## Cinnamara College Girls' Hostel

The College girls' hostel was constructed with the financial assistance of UGC (under 12th Plan) and inaugurated on 22nd July of 2017. The hostel admission is on the basis of merit. The total capacity of the hostel is 30. (Hostel admission fees, seat rent etc. will be notified in due time).

## Cinnamara College Boys' Hostel

## Attendance of the Students

Attendance of student in the regular courses of study is compulsory. The student must appear in examinations arranged by the departmental teacher from time to time. The attendance of all students on Foundation Day (1<sup>st</sup> June) of college, the *tithi* of Shrimanta Sankar Dev, Fresher's day, *Saraswati Puja* and any other functions, Debating, Seminars, Quiz, Public meeting organised by student union, teaching staff, Governing body and ex-student association is also compulsory.

## Allumni Association

## **Ragging**

Ragging is banned at Cinnamara College and any one indulging in ragging during the entire period of his/her study at Cinnamara College is likely to be punished appropriately which may include expulsion from the College, suspension from the College or classes for limited period or fine with a public apology. As per the direction of government of India, every student during admission in this College has to submit an affidavit to this effect.
